

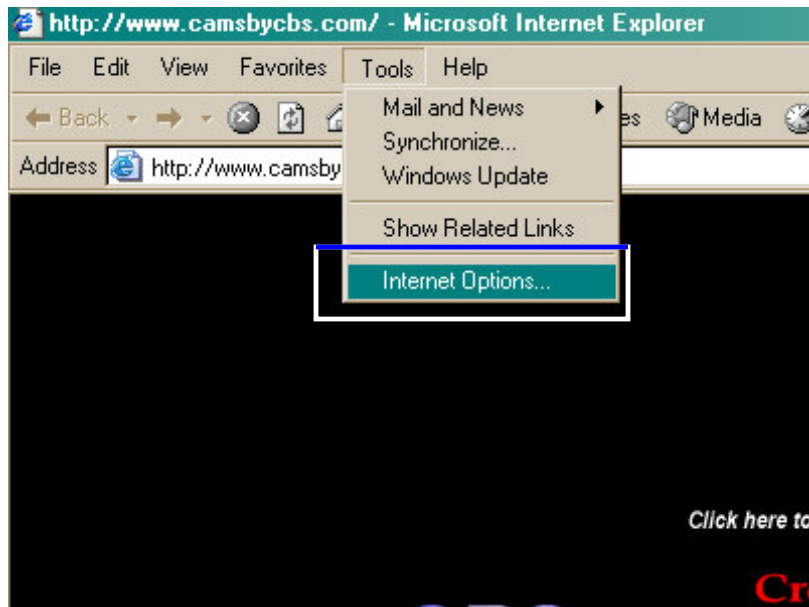
Configuring Internet Explorer for CAMS-ii Transfer Utility for Download PCs

CAMS-ii Release 1.7.0 uses a new file transfer utility that allows simple file transfers between the CAMS-ii host and those PCs (download PC) that you use for uploading and/or downloading files for ATM, ACH, Share Drafts, Cardholder, and so forth.

IMPORTANT: You should configure the Internet Explorer settings on the download (file transfer client) PCs running *before* using the CAMS-ii File Transfer Utility.

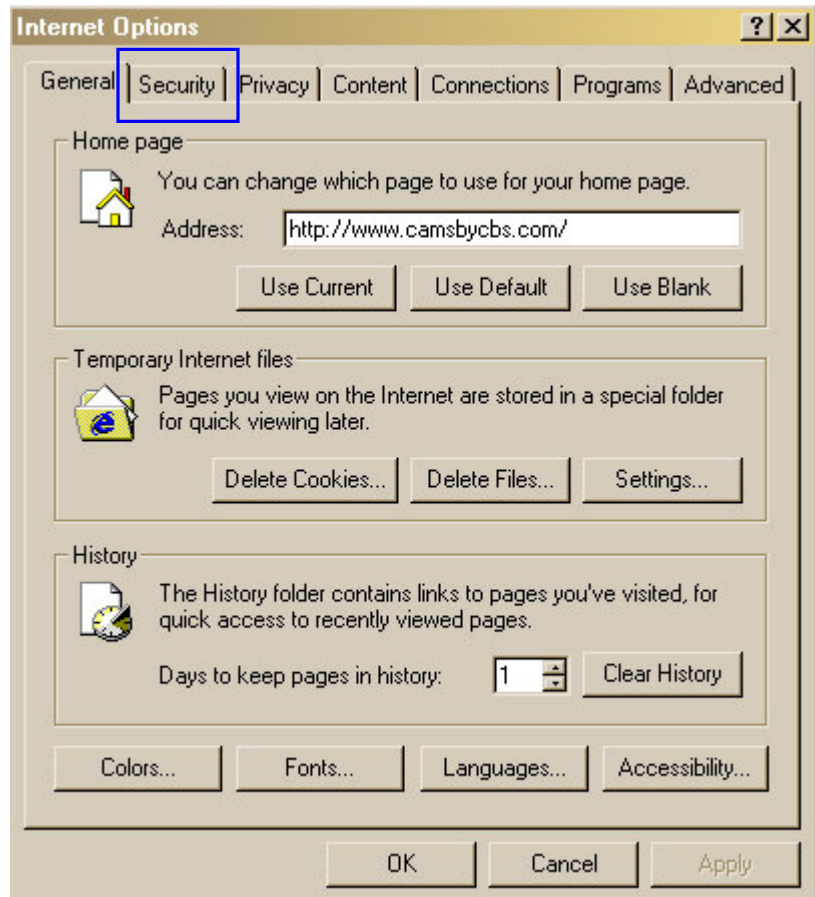
To configure Internet Explorer for the CAMS-ii File Transfer Utility:

1. On the Internet Explorer menu, click **Tools** and select **Internet Options**.



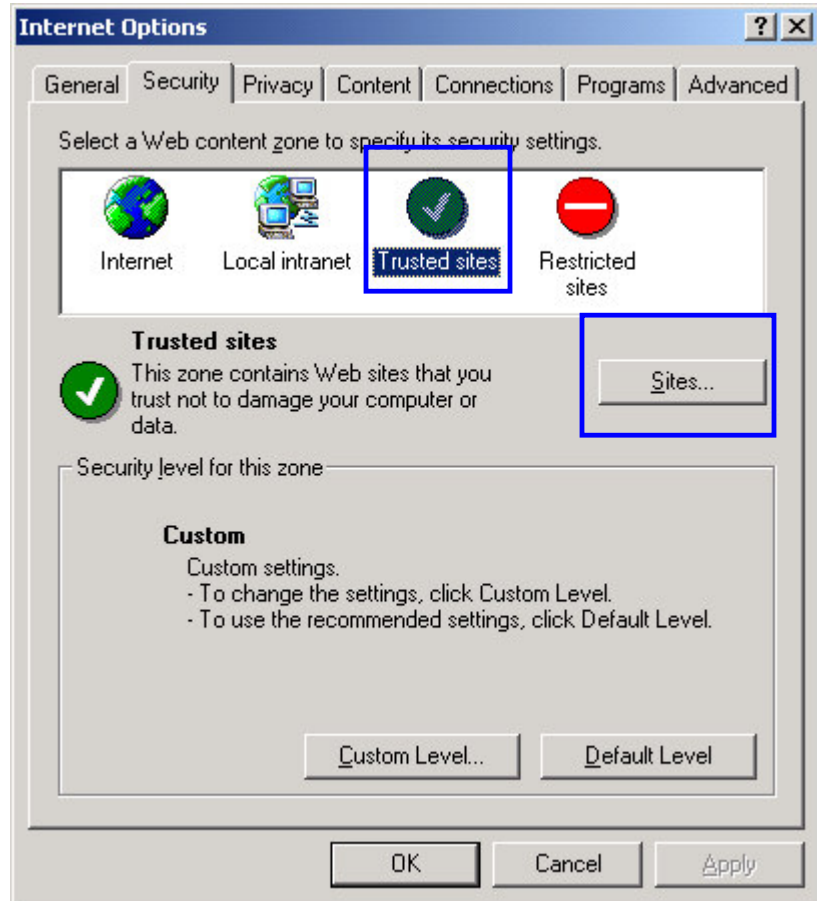

2. On the Internet Options property sheet, click the **Security** tab.



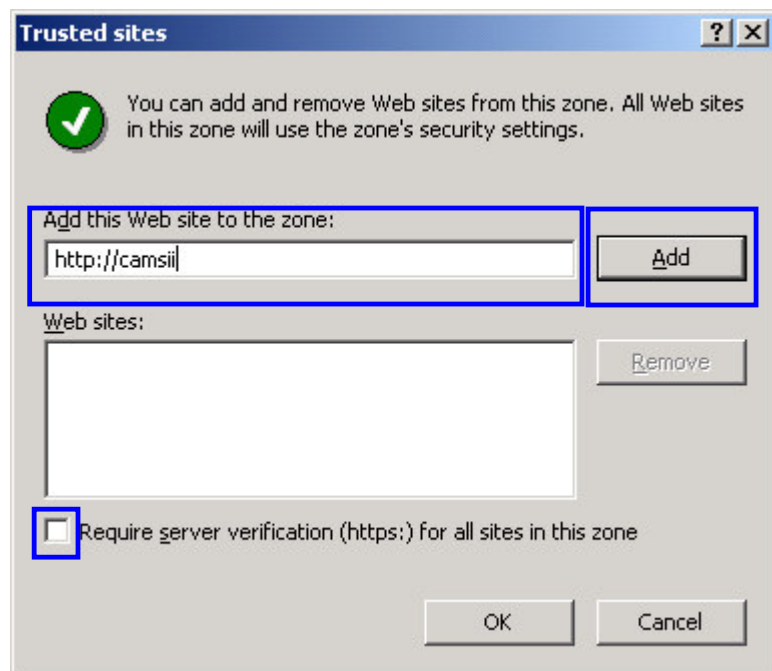

3. On the Security property sheet, click the **Trusted Zone** icon and click **Sites**.



4. On the Trusted Sites dialog box, type `http://camsii` in the **Add this Website to the zone** text box and click **Add**.

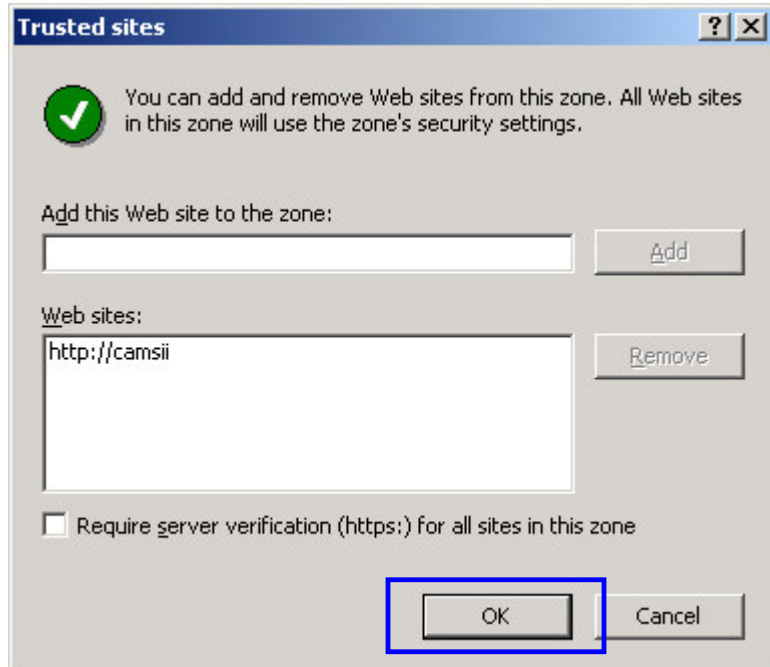
IMPORTANT: Ensure that the **Require server verification ... this zone** check box is unchecked.



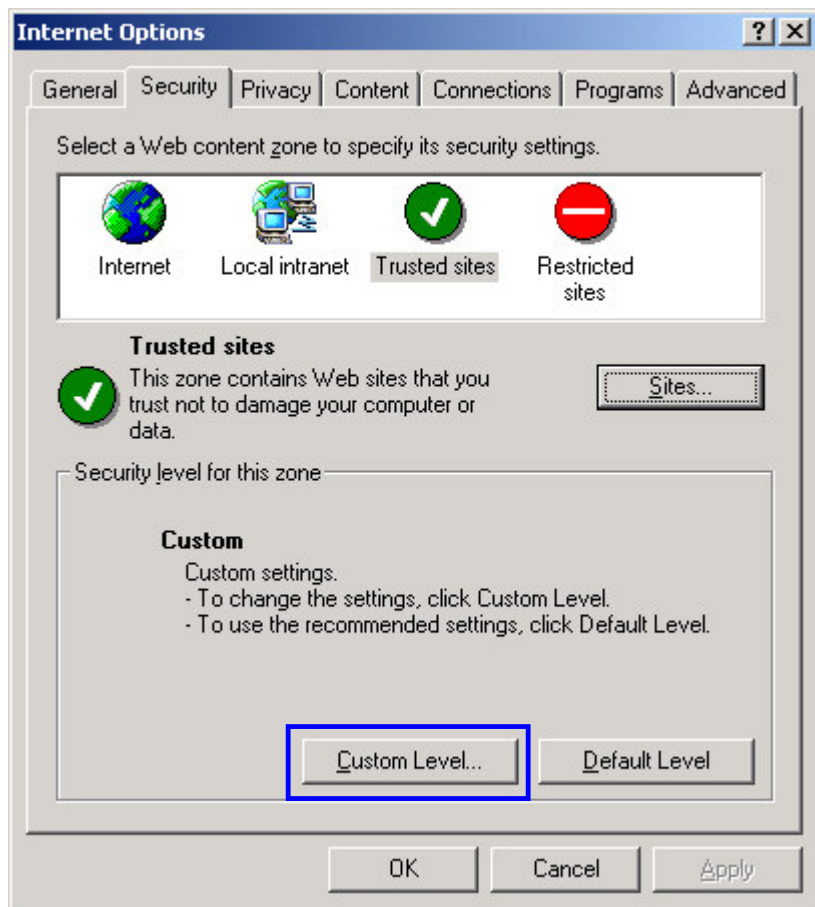

5. The <http://camsii> appears in the Web sites: text box. Click **OK**.

IMPORTANT: Check this page regularly to ensure that there are not any unknown trusted sites in the Web sites text box.

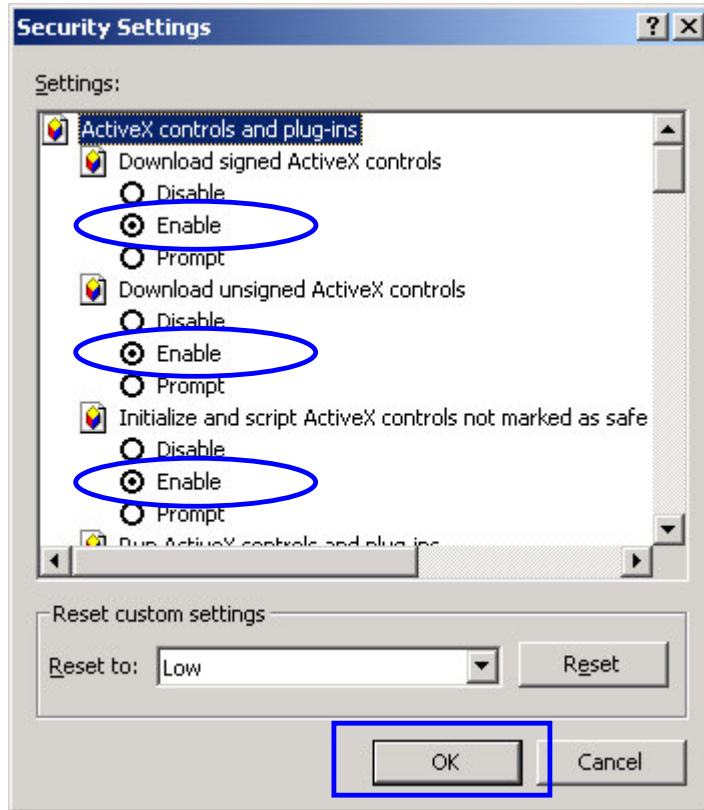


6. Click **Custom Level**.



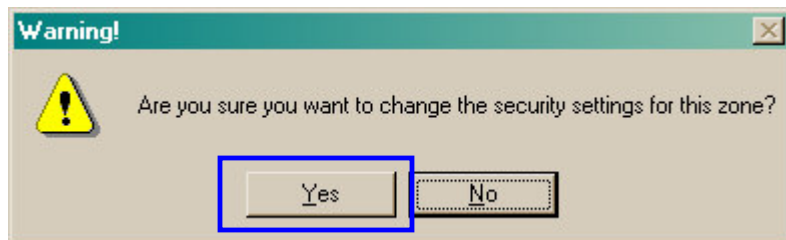

7. In the Settings scrollable menu, click the **Enable** button for the first three ActiveX controls and plug-ins. Click **OK**.



8. A Warning dialog box appears. Click **Yes**.

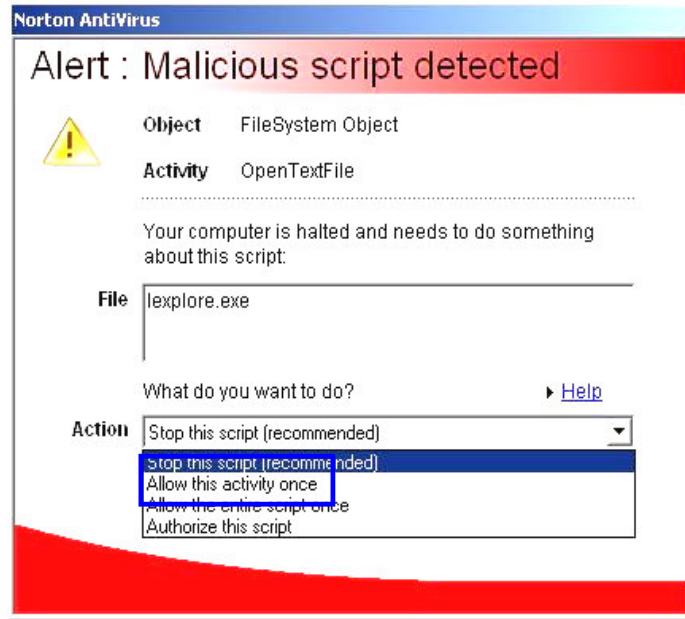
9. Close the Internet Options property sheet.
