Important Notes for this Release

Please take note of these important changes:

- ATM/Debit transactions appear in Member History if the ATM/Debit processor file has separate codes for a *recurring debit* and a *one-time debit*. CAMS-ii always applies NSF charges to a recurring debit, if needed; otherwise, for one-time debits, CAMS-ii follows the Opt-In selections on Personal Data and/or draft record.

New Features

The following features have been added since the last release:

- Added new counters to the draft and share data records to track the number of MTD/YTD transactions that post for which you do not charge due to the NSF Fees Opt-out.

Changes

The following items have changed since the last release.

NOTE: References to CBS Issue Tracking System issues, if applicable, are noted in parentheses at the end of the entry.

- The CBI extract for Equifax now places a zero (0) in the portfolio type field on the CBI reporting extract for charged-off share draft accounts. (Issue #24251)
- Added the 2010 Metro2 Special Comments for credit bureau reporting.

Bugs

The following lists anomalies that have been fixed since the last release. *Most of these were corrected and updated on your system as soon as we were made aware of the problem.:*

- A 911 error occurs when deleting entries from Collections (Issue #22985).
- In the BSA cash display on the Member Balances screen, excessive cash deposit information does not appear for a new member.
